You are receiving this message because you are a Registered Referee in the State of Michigan. Last year you had to login to UsSoccer.info to register for a class and to pay for the registration. Also if you were older than 18 years of age you had to go to Gotsoccer for background check, lastly for those recertifying we had you go to another website to take the online test.

The system that we are moving today will allow us to do all of these things in one site.

This system will be called michiganrefs.gameofficials.net. The link to the home page is below <https://michiganrefs.gameofficials.net/public/default.cfm>

This system will accept the same login information as you had with USSoccer, in most cases it will be the letter "r" and then your 16 digit ID #, and your password will be your last name.

There is nothing for you to do at this time, unless you are thinking of taking a summer class.

All records have been copied unto this system, we would like at your earliest convenience to go on to the site and log in, to make sure your information has been transferred correctly. Our experience is that sometimes an e-mail or phone number has been changed in one system (e.g., the Arbiter) but not across all systems. With this new system, all information is fed to others (e.g., class instruction, US Soccer, assessment, assignors). In addition, the system supports text messaging at no additional cost to the user or to the Michigan Referee Committee. Thus, it is important to make sure that we have your correct phone number so you can receive text messages if you desire.
